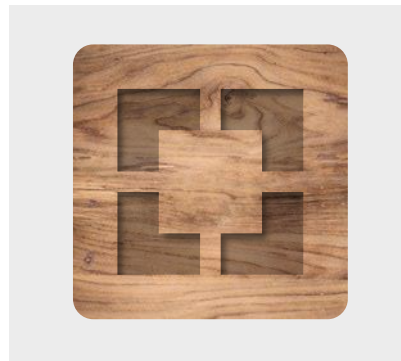

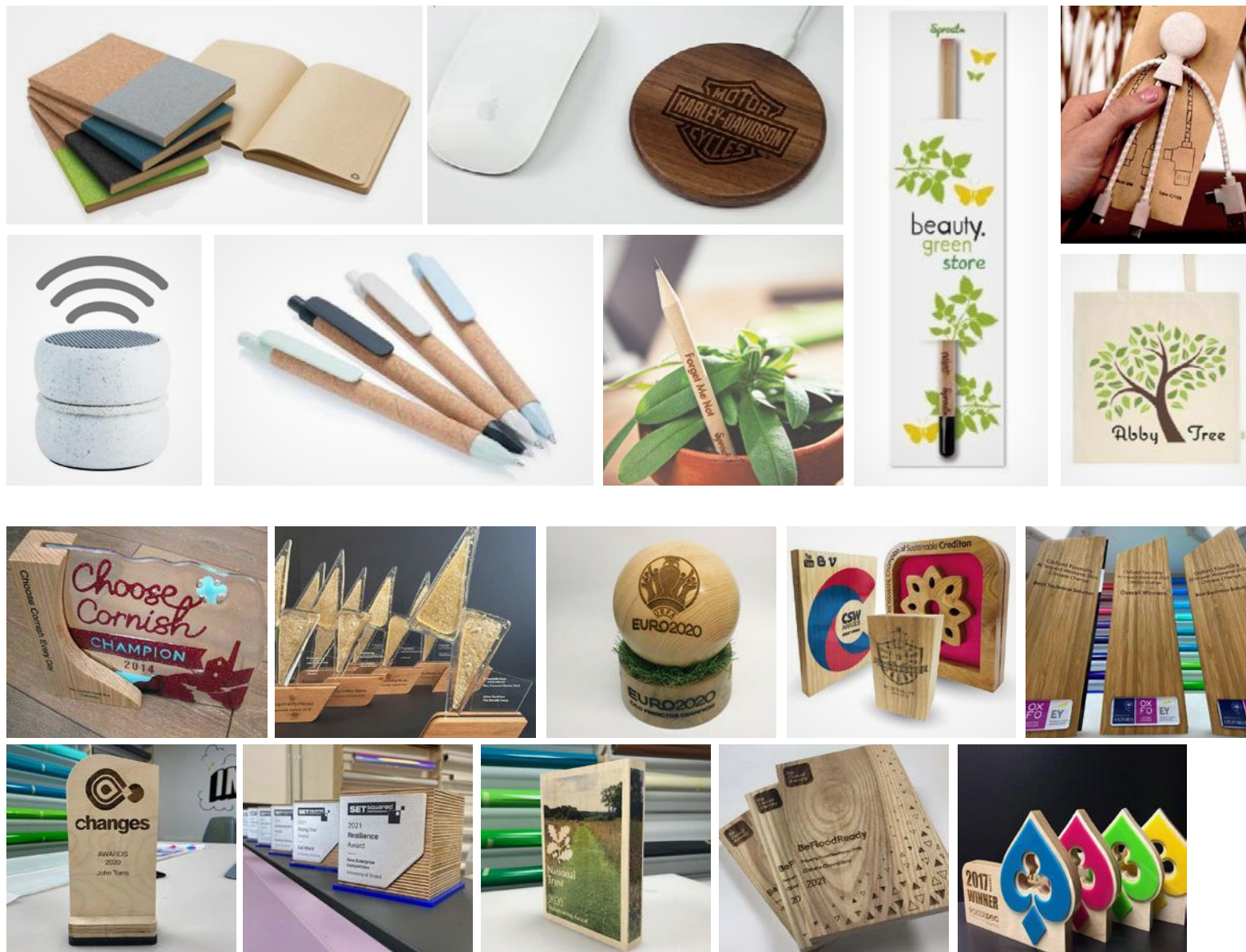
SUSTAINABLE BRANDING INSPIRATION

name tags featuring name, logo and QR code. To be printed on seeded paper.

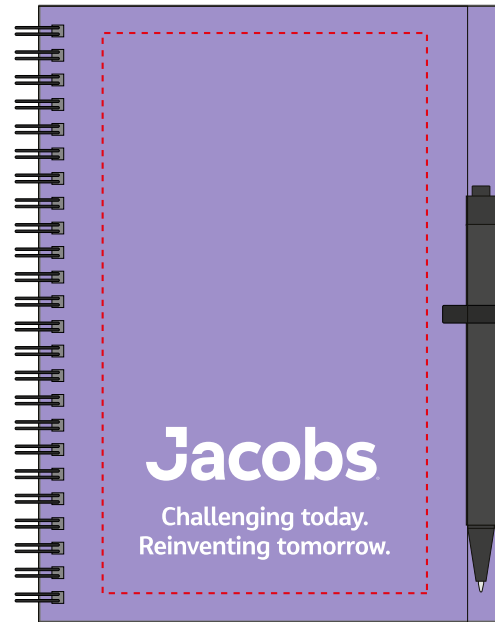
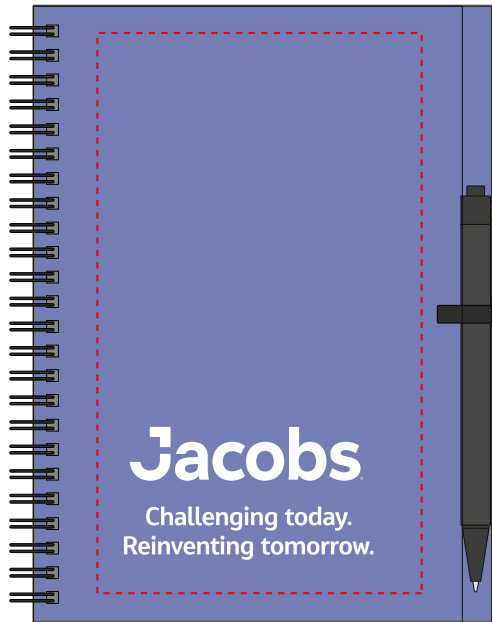

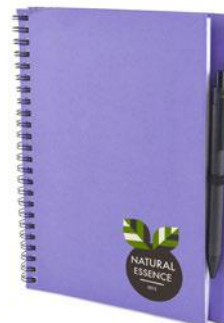
- Table favours**

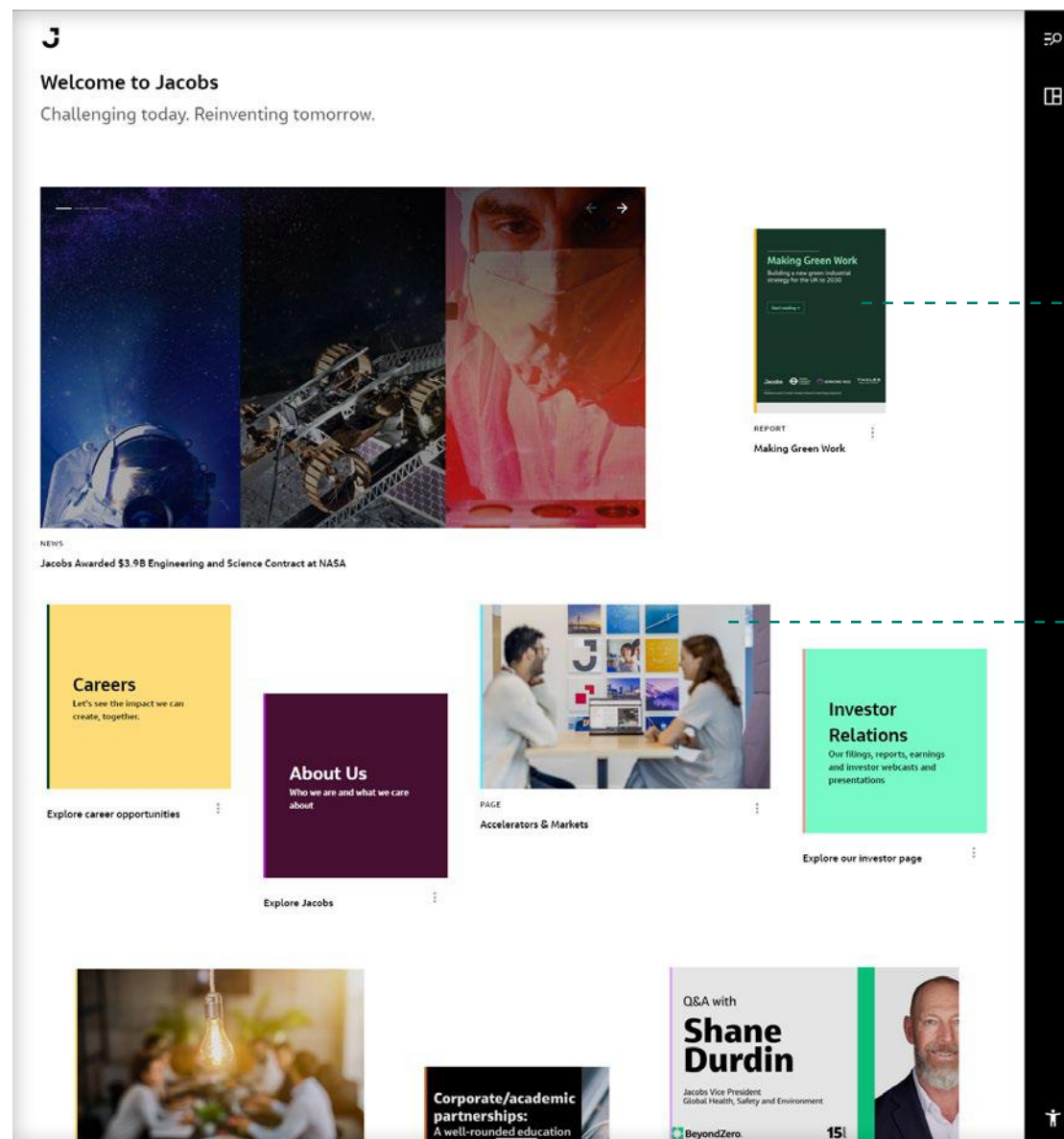
- A more traditional shape curved stand made of fabric
